
The Road to Victory

Allied invasion of France began with landings on the beaches of Normandy. On (3) _____, the Allies liberated Paris from Nazi control. Another famous battle, the (4) ______, took place just a few months later, in December 1944, when German troops pushed west against the Allied forces, causing the German's lines to bulge outward.

In March 1945, the Allies discovered a bridge across the Rhine River that was still intact. They crossed the bridge, pushing German forces back toward Berlin. On April 30, 1945, the Nazi leader (5) ______, sensing imminent defeat, committed suicide. A week later, in May 1945, (6) ______ forces surrendered to the Allies. May 8, 1945, became known as (7) ______, or Victory in Europe Day.

Meanwhile, in the Pacific, U.S. Marines landed on the island of (8) in February 1945. And in (9) ______, American troops invaded Okinawa. Three months later, the United States dropped atomic bombs on the Japanese cities of (10) ______ and (11) ______. On August 15, 1945, the Japan-
